LADH0205 TOBACCO- AND ALCOHOL-FREE SCHOOLS

I. PURPOSE

To implement LADH Policy ADC: Tobacco- and Alcohol-Free Schools.

II. POSITION

A. The ban on the use or possession of tobacco products on school district property shall include all lighted smoking equipment or material, with or without nicotine, including but not limited to electronic, also known as e-cigarettes, vapor cigarettes or e-cigs, or any other electrical inhaler that simulates the act of tobacco smoking.

B. School district employees who violate LADHLADH Policy ADC: Tobacco- and Alcohol-Free Schools, shall be subject to further disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by their immediate supervisors and/or the principal of schools.

C. Students who violate this policy and related policies shall be subject to the disciplinary actions outlined in LADH Policy and Regulation JICH: Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs.
